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**MEETING MINUTES  
NOVEMBER 12, 2007**

The trustees of the Municipal Service District held their monthly meeting on Monday, November 12, 2007 at Christ Church at 6 PM.

Chairman Becker called the meeting to order at 6 p.m. with the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag. He also thanked the newspaper for their prompt response to the change of location for the meeting.

**APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

The Board of Trustees Meeting Minutes for October 8 was discussed. A motion to approve the minutes was made, seconded and unanimously carried to approve the minutes of October 8, 2007.

**PUBLIC COMMENTS**

Speed Newman, 457 Golfview Circle – wanted to discuss the water at Franklin and Golfview during the big rain storms. The County came out to dig a swale through my yard and I told them that they were not and they were going to go back to the engineer to review.

Denis Abromavage, 530 Morning Side Drive – I wanted know where we stand with the County on the ditch. Trustee Long sent a letter to County today with individual concerns to get a response. He will report back at the next meeting.

Lynn Jones, 522 Morning Side Drive – Her concern is the same as Denis Abromavage. She has been working with Trustee Long and Mr. Collins regarding the drainage ditch. She stated that she has had drainage problems too. Trustee Long said the problem is that we don't know who owns the drains or the ditch and is getting conflicting information from the County. Trustee Jurenovich stated that there were 3 drains on Morning Side Drive and that the easement was maintained by the County. Every couple of years they would bring in an excavator with a back hoe to clean out the

easement. Trustee Long said he has invited Mr. Collins to come to our next meeting to speak to this issue. Lynn Jones said she has a petition for the neighbors who this affects to sign.

### **TRUSTEE REPORTS**

#### **POLICE REPORT – TRUSTEE CRANE**

Trustee Crane reported that there were 13 calls outside the MSD for a total 185 minutes. There were 2 parking tickets issued, 94 traffic citations, 98 warnings and 3 traffic stops resulting in an arrest. We had 13 false alarms with no repeats. Lt. Amons reported that the bus stop issue has gotten better now that they have incorporated a new stop and a study is being done on how many tickets are written in this area to see what can be done to decrease the speeders. The County has added some additional signage in that area and markers on the street at the pedestrian crossing.

#### **STREET SIGNS/RIGHT-OF-WAY – TRUSTEE HOLLON**

Trustee Hollon reported that regarding Sunset Park he was going to write an interlocal agreement with the County that states that the MSD will maintain the park. Once this is done they should sign off and put this in their Parks and Recreation Inventory. Secondly, the islands have been fertilized, weeds pulled and the sprinklers have been adjusted.

At one point we have had some interest in putting up new street signs and I have some interest in a company that I'm going to meet with to see what suggestions they have an open it up to the Board.

On Avenue C, I will write another letter to get this sign down.

#### **TREASURERS REPORT – TRUSTEE JURENOVICH**

Trustee Jurenovich reported that we received our last fines and forfeiture check and that everything looks good for the new fiscal year. A motion made that we accept the Treasurers report, seconded and unanimously carried.

#### **ROAD AND SEWERS – TRUSTEE LONG**

Trustee Long reported that he has a JEA certified contractor to check the backflow and they will send an invoice directly to the office.

#### **SANITATION – TRUSTEE REESH**

Trustee Reesh reported that he has been waiting since July to get a response to the additional truck for yard trash. Mr. Foley has sent his budget to corporate but he says their budgets usually do not get approved until January or February. Hopefully we should get a number back from them soon as to how much and extra truck will be.

#### **ELECTRIC AND CABLE – CHAIRMAN BECKER**

Chairman Becker reported that he has nothing to report but has received a letter of resignation from Trustee Donovan.

#### **WEBSITE REPORT – TRUSTEE CRANE**

Trustee Crane reported that he has nothing new to report.

#### **ATTORNEY'S REPORT – ATTORNEY FLOWERS**

Attorney Flowers has nothing new to report.

#### **OLD BUSINESS**

Chairman Becker thanked both Trustee Crane and Jurenovich for their help on the newsletter due

to his health absence. Trustee Jurenovich said he has it at the printer and Trustee Crane has the labels. I will go down to the post office and see how much the postage will be but it should be in the mail before our next meeting.
