- Attendees will have the opportunity to express their views verbally during the public hearing session, by completing comment cards or via email. Your positive involvement is urgently needed by your community, the proposed improvements will not happen without your support
- Speakers will be limited to two minutes per person, responses to comments will not be provided during the formal presentation
